## **Important Notes about Form 1098-T**

- Form 1098-T for 2010 is available via your eLion account, by logging on to <a href="https://my.saintleo.edu">https://my.saintleo.edu</a>.

- Box 2 (Amounts Billed for Qualified Tuition and Related Expenses) of the form 1098-T, consists of tuition related activity on the student account during the period of January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2010. This activity may include pre-registration charges for the Spring 2011 term.
- The Qualified Tuition and Related Expenses reported on the 1098-T (Box 2) may be different from the Qualified Tuition and Related Expenses you may deduct.
- If the student's Qualified Tuition and Related Expenses have been paid for by a third party, Box 2 of Form 1098-T reflects any Qualified Tuition and Related Expenses, less the third-party payments.
